The North American Electric Reliability Council and its affiliate, the North American Electric Reliability Corporation, (jointly "NERC") hereby submit an application seeking recognition as the Electric Reliability Organization ("ERO"). In addition to the paper copy of the application, NERC is also submitting one CD containing a copy of the entire application in a searchable PDF format. NERC requests, to the extent necessary, a waiver of any applicable filing requirements with respect to the filing of this application.

NERC's ERO application consists of:

- This transmittal letter;
- A table of contents for the application;
- A narrative description of NERC's qualifications to serve as the ERO;
- The Certificate of Incorporation of NERC-Corporation (Exhibit A);
- The Bylaws of NERC-Corporation (Exhibit B)
- NERC's Rules of Procedure, including appendices and attachments (Exhibit C);
- A Pro Forma Regional Delegation Agreement (Exhibit D); and
- NERC's Transition Plan (Exhibit E);

In addition to recognition as the ERO, NERC seeks approval of its certificate of incorporation, its bylaws, and its Rules of Procedure (Exhibits A-C). These documents make up NERC's proposed "ERO Rules."

NERC is also contemporaneously filing a separate request for recognition of its proposed reliability standards.

This application and its exhibits were developed using NERC's stakeholder processes and thus are the result of the efforts of all sectors of the electric industry. NERC has posted copies of this application on its website.
