

NEW BRUNSWICK ENERGY AND UTILITIES BOARD

IN THE MATTER of an Application by New Brunswick Power Corporation pursuant to section 119 of the *Electricity Act S.N.B. 2013 c.7* and with respect to Reliability Standards MOD-010, MOD-012, MOD-032 and MOD-033

ORDER

WHEREAS the New Brunswick Energy and Utilities Board (Board) has received an Application from the New Brunswick Power Corporation (NB Power) pursuant to section 119 of the *Electricity Act* and the *Reliability Standards Regulation* seeking:

(a) an Order as follows:

- (1) approving reliability standard MOD-032-1 and NB Appendix MOD-032-1-NB-0;
- (2) approving reliability standard MOD-033-1 and NB Appendix MOD-033-1-NB-0;
- (3) approving retirement of existing Board approved reliability standard MOD-010-0; and
- (4) approving retirement of existing Board approved reliability standard MOD-012-0.

(b) Orders and/or directions with respect to such other matters as the Board sees fit.

AND WHEREAS pursuant to section 8 of the *Reliability Standards Regulation* the Board is required to notify all registered entities, the North American Electric Reliability Corporation (NERC) as the standards body and the Northeast Power Coordinating Council (NPCC) as the compliance body, of this Application;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to section 8 of the *Reliability Standards Regulation* the Board is required to post the Application on its website;

NOW THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. A copy of the Application shall be posted on the Board's website at www.nbeub.ca commencing no later than **Friday July 4, 2014** in both English and French;
2. English and French notices in the form attached hereto and marked "A" are to be provided by Board staff to all registered entities, NERC and NPCC on or before **Friday July 4, 2014**;
3. English and French notices in the form attached hereto and marked "A" are to be posted on the Board's website at www.nbeub.ca commencing no later than **Friday July 4, 2014** and shall remain posted until at least **Tuesday, September 2, 2014**;
4. Registered entities, NERC and NPCC are invited to submit written comment to the Board regarding the Application on or before **Tuesday, September 2, 2014** at general@nbeub.ca or by mail at the address below. Please refer to Matter 254 in your correspondence.

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5. Pursuant to section 8 of the *Reliability Standards Regulation*, the Board shall approve a reliability standard if the requested modifications are not substantive and if the comments received by the Board are not substantive. Also pursuant to

section 8, the Board shall retire a reliability standard if the application indicates the date on which the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) approved the retirement of the equivalent standard and if the comments received by the Board are not substantive.

6. If the requested modifications or comments are substantive, a hearing shall be held by the Board in respect of the Application.
