Dear Ms. Bose:

On March 31, 2010, the North American Electric Reliability Corporation (“NERC”) submitted a Notice of Penalty regarding a violation of Reliability Standards BAL-003-0 Requirement 2.1 and BAL-005-0 Requirement 17 for Michigan Electric Coordinated Systems (MECS). By this filing, NERC clarifies the start date of the duration of the violations. The Settlement Agreement incorrectly states that the alleged violations for BAL-003-0 and BAL-005-0 began on June 18, 2007. However, ReliabilityFirst Corporation has confirmed that the duration of the alleged violation for BAL-003-0 Requirement 2.1 is from June 27, 2007, the date MECS was included on the NERC Compliance Registry, through October 29, 2008, when MECS completed the corresponding Mitigation Plan. The duration of the alleged violation for BAL-005-0 Requirement 17 is from June 27, 2007, through December 23, 2008, when MECS completed the corresponding Mitigation Plan.

Accordingly, NERC respectfully requests that the Commission accept this supplemental filing and issue an order consistent with the comments provided herein.
