On March 31, 2011, the North American Electric Reliability Corporation (“NERC”) submitted a Petition for Approval of Four Transmission Planning System Performance Reliability Standards and Retirement of Four Existing Reliability Standards in the above-referenced docket. It has come to NERC’s attention that on page 11 of the filing, the Implementation Plan effective date should read “**sixty** months after the first day of the first calendar quarter following applicable regulatory approval,” instead of the current “**six** months.”

Accordingly, NERC respectfully requests that the Commission take note of this errata filing, and issue an order consistent with NERC’s filings submitted in this proceeding.
