Election Results for Segments 1 through 8 and Next Steps

Each of the 10 industry segments that make up the North American Electric Reliability Corporation (NERC) Standards Committee (SC) had a vacancy to fill a two-year term beginning January 1, 2016 and ending December 31, 2017. A nomination period was held from September 29 through October 19, 2015 for each segment. A list of nominees is provided below.

Election Results

An election for Segments 1 through 8 was held from October 20, 2015 to October 29, 2015. NERC has verified the votes cast and confirmed the results. The elected nominees all received the highest total number of votes in that segment and received a simple majority of the votes cast in that segment. No nominations were received for the two-year vacancy in **Segment 9**; therefore, the SC will determine if a special election will be held for that segment.

Segment 10 (Regional Entities) has an alternative election procedure, as permitted by Appendix 3B of the NERC Rules of Procedure. Pursuant to that alternative election procedure, Guy Zito, Northeast Power Coordinating Council, has been elected to represent Segment 10.
