Nomination Results | Special Election Segment 9 2017-2018 Term Election

February 17-27, 2017

The Standards Committee (SC) nomination period for special elections for the Segment 7 and Segment 9, 2017-2018 term closed February 8, 2017.

Michael Marchand was the only individual nominated to represent Segment 9 for the two-year term. No nominations were received for Segment 7.

An election will begin on Friday, February 17, 2017 for Segment 9, and will remain open for 10 calendar days closing on Monday, February 27, 2017 at 8:00 p.m. Eastern. Each individual or entity that is a **member of Segment 9** may vote. Although Michael Marchand is running unopposed, he must receive at least one vote to be elected to the SC.

- Receive a simple majority of the votes cast in that Segment.
