

## Standards Committee Segment Representative Election Results

### Election Results and Next Steps

Each of the 10 industry segments that make up the North American Electric Reliability Corporation (NERC) Standards Committee (SC) had a vacancy to fill a two-year term beginning January 1, 2017 and ending December 31, 2018. A nomination period was held from September 19 through October 11, 2016 for each segment. A list of nominees is provided below.

#### Election Results

An election for Segments 1 through 9 was held from October 17, 2016 to October 26, 2016. NERC has verified the votes cast and confirmed the results.
