It is not required that the nominee be the same person as the entity's Registered Ballot Body representative for that Segment. Instructions are provided in <u>Appendix 3B</u> of the NERC Rules of Procedure – *Procedure for Election of Members of the NERC Standards Committee Procedure*.
