Segment 1 Representative Runoff Election Results 2020-2021 Term Election – Segments 1-10 (Two-year term)

Each of the 10 industry segments that make up the North American Electric Reliability Corporation (NERC) Standards Committee (SC) had a vacancy to fill a two-year term beginning January 1, 2020 and ending December 31, 2021. An election for Segments 1 through 9 was held from October 21, 2019 to October 30, 2019. NERC staff verified the votes cast and confirmed the results.

Segment 1 (Transmission Owners) John Babik and Sean Cavote received an equal number of votes. In accordance with Appendix 3B of the Rules of Procedure, a second ballot, or run-off election, was held between the two candidates from November 5-14, 2019.

Election Results

In the second ballot, John Babik received the highest total number of votes for Segment 1 and received a simple majority of the votes cast in that segment. John Babik has been elected to fill a two-year term for this segment.
