Standards Committee Nomination Form

2021-2022 Term Election – Segments 1-10 (Two-year term) Special Election Segment 7 – One-year Term

The North American Electric Reliability Corporation (NERC) <u>Standards Committee</u> (SC) has two members from each of the ten industry segments. Each SC member is elected by the segment he or she represents. The SC reports to the NERC Board of Trustees and oversees the development of NERC Reliability Standards by performing tasks governed by the <u>Standard Processes Manual</u>, the <u>Standards Committee</u> <u>Charter</u>, and the <u>SC Work Plan</u>.

Anyone may submit a nomination. To be eligible for nomination, a nominee shall be an employee or agent of an entity belonging in the applicable Segment. **To allow verification of affiliation, a nominee must be a registered user in the NERC Registered Ballot Body** (RBB). It is not required that the nominee be the same person as the entity's RBB representative for the applicable Segment. Instructions are provided in <u>Appendix 3B</u> of the NERC Rules of Procedure – *Procedure for Election of Members of the NERC Standards Committee Procedure*. Completed nomination forms will be posted on the <u>SC Nomination and Elections webpage</u>.

Nominations are currently being accepted for each of the ten segments for a two-year term. In addition, we are seeking nominations for Segment 7 for one-year term (2020-2021).

Mr. Brumfield is an employee at American Transmission Company LLC (ATC) where he has held his current position as the Regulatory Compliance Manager since July 2017. In this role, Mr. Brumfield is responsible for leading the overall development, and directing the activities and execution of ATC's regulatory strategy (2) monitoring ATC's regulatory environment (3) representing ATC at industry committees and trade organization meetings; and (4) working



with ATC legal staff to develop regulatory strategies and resolve compliance and enforcement related issues.

Prior to joining ATC Mr. Brumfield was employed at Wisconsin Energy Corporation (WEC) from 2012 to 2017. WEC is an electric and natural gas utility with generation and distribution operations in Wisconsin, Illinois, and Michigan's Upper Peninsula. While at WEC Mr. Brumfield held various leadership roles in the Operations and Engineering-Major Projects work group and the Operations Support group where he was responsible for managing regulatory obligations, standards development, compliance, and asset management. During his time at WEC Mr. Brumfield served as Chair of several generation and distribution regional committees and councils that were tasked with promoting and strengthening governmental and industry partnerships. Mr. Brumfield utilized these committees and councils as a forum to facilitate discussions related to standards interpretation and standards execution by utility and governmental employees focused on the reliable design, construction, operation, and maintenance of electric and gas facilities.

Mr. Brumfield was employed at AT&T Inc. from 1998 to 2012 where he was a member of the Field Network Operations team in Southeastern Wisconsin. While at AT&T, Mr. Brumfield's career progressed from a Sr. technical expert and Subject Matter Expert to network design engineer, then ultimately a leadership role with responsibility for a team of engineers that focused on the design and construction of a reliable and resilient communications network, program management, regulatory affairs, compliance, and business development.
