the Order and new data going forward (P. 89). The data is intended			
to promote greater understanding of GMD events and their potential			
impacts to the reliable operation of the Bulk-Power System.			
NERC and the Geomagnetic Disturbance Task Force (GMDTF) have			
drafted the <u>proposed GMD Data Request</u> for the collection of GIC			
monitoring and magnetometer data as required by Order No. 830.			
The GMD Data Request applies to U.S. registered Transmission			
Owners and Generator Owners. Although not required, Canadian			
registered Transmission Owners and Generator Owners are			
encouraged to participate.			
At the conclusion of the comment period, NERC staff and the GMDTF			
will review the comments received, consider revisions, and			
determine next steps in accordance with NERC Rules of Procedure.

NEW Disturbance Report and Resources Posted

On October 9, 2017, the Canyon 2 Fire caused two transmission system faults east of Los Angeles. Both faults resulted in the reduction of solar photovoltaic (PV) generation across a wide region of the Southern California Edison footprint. Approximately 900 MW of solar PV resources were lost as a result of these events. NERC and the Western Electricity Coordinating Council gathered information related to performance of the solar



PV fleet, working closely with the Generator Owners, Generator Operators, and inverter manufacturers at the affected generating facilities. The <u>disturbance report</u> describes the event analysis, key findings, and recommendations moving forward to ensure reliable operation of the bulk power system.

An informational webinar discussing the Key Findings and Recommendations from the Canyon 2 Fire Disturbance and the Blue Cut Fire Disturbance was held on February 15, 2018. The <u>presentation</u> and <u>streaming webinar</u> have been posted.

NEW Nomination Period Open for 2018 Planning Committee Special Election
