monitoring and magnetometer data as required by Order No. 830.	
The GMD Data Request applies to U.S. registered Transmission

encouraged to participate.

## BOARD OF TRUSTEES AND FERC ACTION

#### **NEW NERC Filings**

On March 5, 2018, NERC and MRO and SERC filed with FERC a joint petition for approvals in connection with the termination of the Regional Delegation Agreement with SPP, Inc.

On March 7, 2018, NERC and WECC filed with FERC filed a joint petition for approval of retirement of Regional Reliability Standard VAR-002-WECC-2.

On March 8, 2018, NERC and WECC filed with FERC a joint petition for approval of proposed regional Reliability Standard BAL-004-WECC-3 --Automatic Time Error Correction. The purpose of proposed regional Reliability Standard BAL-004-WECC-3 is to maintain Interconnection frequency and to ensure that Time Error Corrections and Primary Inadvertent Interchange payback are effectively conducted in a manner that does not adversely affect the reliability of the Western Interconnection.

On March 9, 2018, NERC and WECC filed with FERC a joint petition for approval of retirement of Regional Reliability Standard PRC-004-WECC-2.

#### **NEW FERC Issuances**

On March 9, 2018, FERC issued a <u>letter order</u> accepting NERC's November 21, 2017 <u>filing</u> of proposed revisions to its Rules of Procedure (ROP) related to ensuring that the votes of the Independent System Operators and Regional Transmission Organizations in Segment 2 are appropriately represented in the Registered Ballot Body (RBB) voting structure.
