NERC proposes to request that these revisions become effective immediately after filing with FERC.	
NERC requests comments on the proposed revisions to the NERC Rules of Procedure. The 45-day comment period begins August 27, 2018 and ends October 11, 2018.

#### **NEW FERC Issuances**

On September 5, 2018, FERC issued a <u>letter order</u> accepting the <u>March 7, 2018</u> filing of the joint petition submitted by NERC and WECC seeking approval of retirement of regional Reliability Standard VAR-002-WECC-2 – Automatic Voltage Regulators.

On September 6, 2018, FERC issued a letter order accepting the revisions to the MRO Bylaws in Docket No. RR18-8-000.

#### **NEW NERC Filings**

On September 6, 2018, NERC filed with FERC a <u>petition</u> for approval of proposed Reliability Standard VAR-001-5 – Voltage and Reactive Control and retirement of currently effective Reliability Standard VAR-001-4.2.

On September 7, 2018, NERC submitted to FERC an <u>informational filing</u> regarding Proposed Supply Chain Risk Management Reliability Standards.
