NEW Nomination Period Open for Project Management and Oversight Subcommittee

Nominations are being sought for Project Management and Oversight Subcommittee (PMOS) members through October 9, 2018.

The PMOS is seeking to fill one to three positions. Desirable qualifications include candidates knowledgeable of the Standard Processes Manual and have a broad historical knowledge of Reliability Standards. advising and supporting standard drafting teams, enhanced periodic review teams, and special projects to achieve standard goals specified in the Reliability Standards Development Plan. The PMOS reports to the Standards Committee (SC).

The PMOS maintains and updates a <u>Project Tracking Spreadsheet</u> which shows the expected and actual project milestones for each project. In addition, the PMOS works with NERC staff in maintaining a deliberate pace of development, while staggering posting periods of projects to ensure there is no industry burden during comment periods. Each project has an assigned PMOS liaison that maintains active engagement with their assigned standard development project team(s) and developer(s), as well as, reports updates during PMOS meetings and conference calls to other subcommittee members and SC leadership.

Use the <u>electronic form</u> to submit a nomination. If you experience issues using the electronic form, contact <u>Wendy Muller</u>. An unofficial Word version of the nomination form is posted in the <u>Related Files</u> section of the <u>PMOS web page</u>. By submitting a nomination form, you are indicating your willingness and agreement to participate in PMOS meetings. If selected, members are expected to attend face-to-face PMOS meetings, as well as participate in all the PMOS meetings held via conference calls. The time commitment for this effort is one face-to-face

meeting per quarter held prior to the SC meeting with four to eight conference calls scheduled as needed. SC members and others interested in NERC Reliability Standards are encouraged to submit nominations for representatives on the PMOS.

- EOP-006-3 (System Restoration Coordination) applies only to Reliability Coordinators, and the effective date of the Standard is 4/1/2019. EOP-006-3 replaces EOP-006-2.

BOARD OF TRUSTEES AND FERC ACTION

NEW NERC Filings

On September 26, 2018, NERC, Midwest Reliability Organization (MRO), and Reliability First Corporation (RF) filed with FERC a <u>joint petition</u> seeking approval for the proposed registration transfer request of Wisconsin Public Service Corporation and Upper Michigan Energy Resources Corporation from the MRO footprint to the RF footprint. At this time, the joint petition remains un-docketed. NERC will update the docket number on its website when it is assigned.

On September 28, 2018, NERC submitted to FERC an informational filing regarding BAL-001-2 in Docket No. RM14-10-000.

On September 28, 2018, NERC also filed with FERC an annual report on Wide-Area Analysis of Technical Feasibility Exceptions in Docket No. RM10-1-000 and RM13-3-000.

NEW FERC Issuances

On August 17, 2018, NERC filed with FERC a <u>petition</u> for approval of proposed Reliability Standard BAL-002-3 – Disturbance Control Standard – Contingency Reserve for Recovery from a Balancing Contingency Event. On September 25, FERC issued a delegated <u>letter order</u> approving NERC's August petition filing in Docket No. RD18-7-000.

On June 4, 2018, NERC filed with FERC a <u>petition</u> for approval of amendments to its Bylaws. On September 25, FERC issued a <u>letter order</u> accepting the revisions to the NERC Bylaws in Docket No. RR18-7-000.
