On October 24, 2018, NERC filed with FERC <u>comments</u> in Docket No. RM05-5-026 in support of FERC's notice of proposed rulemaking issued on October 4, 2018, proposing to remove the incorporation by reference of the Wholesale Electric Quadrant (WEQ) WEQ-006 Time Error Correction Business Practice Standards as adopted by the North American Energy Standards Board in its WEQ Version 003.0 Businesses Practice Standards.
