### **NEW Two RSAWs Posted**

Two new Reliability Standard Audit Worksheets (RSAWs) are now available on the RSAW page of NERC's website under the heading "Current RSAWs for Use:"

- EOP-005-3 (System Restoration from Blackstart Resources) applies to Generator Operators and Transmission Operators, as well as Transmission Owners and Distribution Providers identified in the Transmission Operators restoration plan. The effective date of the Standard is April 4, 2019. EOP-005-3 will replace EOP-005-2.
- EOP-008-2 (Loss of Control Center Functionality) applies to Balancing
   Authorities, Reliability Coordinators, and Transmission Operators. The effective date of the Standard is April 4, 2019. EOP-008-2 replaces EOP-008-1.
