NEW Coordinated Functional Registration Enhancement on the ERO Portal Launched

The Coordinated Functional Registration (CFR) Enhancement for requirement parts is now ready for use by Registered Entities to create, submit, and update CFRs. This enhancement was identified in discussions with CFR participants and in a survey to registered entity CFR participants, regional staff, and NERC staff regarding level of effort to prepare, review, record, and publish CFRs.

To access this portal you must have access to the <u>ERO Portal (Formerly NERC MyAccount)</u>. Instructions for registering for the ERO Portal and CFR Portal are included in the "CFR Portal User Guide" and PowerPoint training presentation located on the <u>Organization Registration</u> page on <u>NERC.COM</u> under "Reference Documents." A link to the CFR Portal is also located on the Organization Registration page under "NERC Registration Tools."

Additional training will be coordinated with registered entities over the next several weeks. A follow-up survey will be sent out on Friday, December 14, 2018 to CFR participants, regional staff, and NERC staff. Annual Sector Election Ballot Period Opens for Member Representatives Committee

The election period for the NERC Member Representatives Committee (MRC) Annual Sector Election began on December 7, 2018 and ends at midnight on December 17, 2018. The newly elected representatives' terms will expire in February 2021.

In addition, John Hughes, a representative of the Large End-Use Electricity Customer sector on the MRC, resigned effective August 20, 2018, creating a vacancy in Sector 8 with a term ending February 2020. Therefore, Sector 8 is electing two members. The candidate receiving the highest vote in the sector will serve a two-year term and the second highest candidate will serve a one-year term.

BOARD OF TRUSTEES AND FERC ACTION

NEW NERC Filings

On December 14, 2018, NERC and Texas RE filed with FERC a joint petition for approval of retirement of Texas RE Regional Reliability Standard IRO-006-TRE-1 – IROL and SOL Mitigation in the ERCOT Region. At this time, the petition remains un-docketed. NERC will update the docket number on its website when it is assigned.

On December 14, 2018, NERC submitted to FERC an <u>informational filing</u> regarding the 2019–2021 Reliability Standards Development Plan in Docket Nos. RM05-17-000, RM05-25-000 and RM06-16-000. The 2019 Development Plan provides a status update on active development projects, a forecast of future work to be undertaken by industry participants and NERC throughout the upcoming year, and an analysis comparing completed projects and development accomplishments with the prior year's Reliability Standards Development Plan. This informational filing was submitted in accordance with Section 310 of the NERC Rules of Procedure.
