NEW Comment Period Open for WECC Regional Variance for IRO-002-5 - Reliability Coordination – Monitoring and Analysis: The Western Electricity Coordinating Council (WECC) requested that NERC post the WECC Regional Variance for IRO-002-5 – Reliability Coordination – Monitoring and Analysis for industry review and comment in accordance with the NERC Rules of Procedure. As the Western Interconnection moves to a multi-Reliability Coordinator (RC) environment, focused coordination of those RCs will become critical. WECC developed a proposed Regional Variance to NERC Reliability Standard IRO-002-5 – Reliability Coordination – Monitoring and Analysis to ensure coordination between each of those RCs. The proposed Variance does not change any of the continent-wide Requirements. The WECC Board of Directors adopted the proposed Variance on March 6, 2019. Prior to NERC Board adoption, the proposed Variance will be inserted into proposed Reliability Standard IRO-002-6, which is currently being balloted as part of the ongoing Project 2018-03 – Standards Efficiency Retirements project. 

## **Submittal Process Change for Standards Inquiries**

Going forward, all Standards-related inquiries, including submissions of Standard Authorization Requests (SAR) and Requests for Interpretations (RFI), should be submitted via the <u>NERC Help Desk</u>. In order to submit your inquiry or request you must:

- 1) Go to the NERC Help Desk site.
- 2) Enter your contact information.
- 3) Select "Standards" from the Applications menu.
- 4) Select the appropriate option from the Standards Subcategories menu. If you are submitting a SAR or RFI, you must select the option here for proper routing. If you are uncertain, select "Other."





- 5) Attach your SAR or RFI form (if applicable).
- 6) Enter a description.
- 7) Submit.

Upon submission, you will receive an email confirmation with an assigned ticket number from the Help Desk. The ticket number can be used to inquire on status of inquiry/submission.

Additionally, NERC has created <u>Standard Authorization Requests</u> and <u>Requests for Interpretations</u> pages on the Standards site. Requests that have not been accepted by the Standards Committee will be posted on this site. Any SAR or RFI that has been accepted by the Standards Committee can be found on the appropriate page. ## **BOARD OF TRUSTEES AND FERC ACTION**

## **NEW NERC Filings**

On March 7, 2019, NERC filed with FERC a <u>petition</u> for approval of proposed Reliability Standard CIP-008-6 – Cyber Security – Incident Reporting and Response Planning. Proposed Reliability Standard CIP-008-6 addresses FERC's directives in Order No. 848. At this time, the joint petition remains un-docketed by FERC. NERC will update the docket number on its website when it is assigned.

On March 6, 2019, NERC and WECC filed with FERC a <u>joint petition</u> for approval of proposed Regional Reliability Standard IRO-006-WECC-3 - Qualified Path Unscheduled Flow (USF) Relief. Proposed Regional Reliability Standard IRO-006-WECC-3 addresses the requests for transmission relief due to unscheduled flow on Qualified Paths in the Western Interconnection. At this time, the joint petition remains un-docketed by FERC. NERC will update the docket number on its website when it is assigned.

On March 6, 2019, NERC submitted to FERC an <u>errata</u> to the joint petition for approvals in connection with the dissolution of FRCC RE in Docket No. RR19-4-000. The errata provides an updated list of Registered Entities that NERC proposes to transfer from FRCC RE's footprint to SERC Reliability Corporation's footprint.
