NEW Update on Centralized Organization Registration ERO System Project

The <u>Centralized Organization Registration ERO System (CORES) Technology Project</u> is progressing according to plan and is scheduled to launch in June 2019. A <u>FAQ</u> document has been posted to the CORES project page.

CORES, which combines the registration functions currently managed in OATI – webCDMS, Guidance – CITS, and CRATS into a consolidated registration system, is anticipated to be launched the week of June 17th, 2019, with multiple training opportunities to be provided by the ERO. NEW FERC Approves Petition for FRCC RE Dissolution Actions

NERC is pleased with FERC's <u>order</u> approving the termination of the Regional Delegation Agreement between NERC and Florida Reliability Coordinating Council, Inc. (FRCC), as well as the transfer of registered entities within FRCC to SERC and the revisions to SERC's Regional Delegation Amendment reflecting their changed geographic footprint.

NERC appreciates FERC's prompt action and will continue to work with the Regional Entities and affected registered entities toward a seamless transition, expected to occur on July 1, 2019, with FRCC ceasing operations as a Regional Entity on August 31, 2019.
