BOARD OF TRUSTEES AND FERC ACTION

NEW NERC Filings

On May 21, 2019, NERC submitted to FERC a <u>petition</u> for the approval of proposed Reliability Standard CIP-003-8 - Cyber Security — Security Management Controls. The proposed Reliability Standard addresses FERC's directive from <u>Order No. 843</u> to develop modifications to the standard to mitigate the risk of malicious code that could result from third-party transient electronic devices for low impact BES Cyber Systems. At this time, the petition remains un-docketed by FERC. NERC will update the docket number on its website when it is assigned.
