Bulk Power System (BPS) Impacts Due to Severe Disruptions on the			
<u>Natural Gas System</u> . In the report, NERC made recommendations for			
assessing disruptions to natural gas infrastructure and related impacts			
to the reliable operation of the BPS in planning studies, several of			
which were assigned to the NERC Planning Committee (PC).			
In November 2018, the PC provided the NERC Board of Trustees with			
their action plan to address concerns from the special assessment. The			
action plan included development of the <u>Fuel Assurance and Fuel</u> -			
Related Reliability Risk Analysis for the BPS Draft Reliability Guideline			
by the newly formed Electric Gas Working Group (EGWG). The draft			
reliability guideline contains proposed guidance for industry planners			



to use in evaluating fuel and energy supply risks within their generation resource portfolios to address potential impacts to the BPS. The NERC PC Executive Committee (PCEC) reviewed the draft guideline and authorized posting for industry comment. For more information or assistance, please contact Scott Barfield McGinnis .			
Comment Period Open for Regional Reliability Standard BAL-001-TRE-2: The Texas Reliability Entity (Texas RE) requested that NERC post Regional Reliability Standard BAL-001-TRE-2 for industry review and comment in accordance with the NERC Rules of Procedure. Texas RE received a Standard Authorization Request seeking: (i) to remove the governor deadband and droop setting requirements for steam turbines in a combined cycle train and (ii) clarification of the responsible entity for Frequency Measurable Event exclusion requests. The Texas RE drafting team summarized all of the revisions made to Regional Reliability Standard BAL-001-TRE-2, including template edits, in the Summary of Changes . NEW ReliabilityFirst to Host Internal Control Workshop in 2020

On February 12, 2020, ReliabilityFirst will host an Internal Control Workshop at its headquarters in Cleveland, Ohio. This workshop, open to all interested participants, will be a working session that focuses on one CIP and O&P Standard, with the goal that each entity will leave with documented controls applicable to their organization, relative to the standard.

During this working session attendees will be:

- Introduced to the ReliabilityFirst Internal Controls Framework (based on COSO);
- Trained on Internal Controls and how to use the framework;
- Provided templates to capture Internal Controls based on the framework; and
- Given time and guidance to complete the templates relative to entity SME and PCC processes.

NEW Supply Chain Small Group General Session Presentations Posted

NERC hosted small group advisory meetings with registered entities, standards developers, and Regional Entities to assess the implementation of the CIP Supply Chain Standards (i.e., CIP-013-1 – Cyber Security – Supply Chain Risk Management, CIP-005-6 – Cyber Security – Electronic Security Perimeter(s), and CIP-010-3 – Cyber Security – Configuration Change Management and Vulnerability Assessments)

NERC held a general interest session and live webinar during which industry speakers and NERC staff discussed supply chain issues and solutions. Following that, ERO Enterprise staff held closed one-on-one discussions with registered entities' supply chain security experts to discuss concerns pertinent to each entity's implementation of the Supply Chain Standards.

NEW Nomination Period Open for Credential Maintenance Working Group

The NERC System Operator Certification Program is holding open nominations to fill eight vacancies on the newly formed <u>Credential Maintenance</u> <u>Working Group (CMWG)</u>. The CMWG reports to the Personnel Certification Governance Committee (PCGC) and is responsible for developing and maintaining the Credential Maintenance Program under the general guidelines set by the PCGC. Successful candidates are expected to protect the integrity of the System Operator Certification process, serve a two-year term, attend and participate in four in-person CMWG meetings, and participate in various conference calls and subcommittee tasks.

The PCGC Nominating Subcommittee will consider nominees with the following qualifications:

- Experience in the electric utility industry. Parallel experience of training in the electric utility industry will suffice for both training and industry experience. Experience in NERC Certified System Operator Training is desired.
- Advanced training expertise, preferably in the bulk transmission system and Bulk Electric System operations.
- Knowledge and experience applying a systematic approach to training.
- Knowledge regarding reliable operations within their organizations.

Nominations are open to all interested parties and self-nominations are encouraged. If you are interested or know someone who is interested, please fill out the CMWG nomination form and email it to Barb Nutter, manager of Personnel Certification at NERC. The nomination period ends on January 14, 2020.
