NEW NERC Filing

On February 14, 2020, NERC submitted to FERC a compliance <u>filing</u> consisting of the unaudited report of the NERC budget-to-actual spending variances during the preceding quarter. This compliance filing was submitted in accordance with FERC's January 16, 2013 Order, which approved a settlement agreement between the FERC Office of Enforcement and NERC, related to findings and recommendations arising out of its 2012 performance audit of NERC.
