CORES Survey Notice

The ERO Enterprise will be seeking feedback regarding functionality on the ERO Portal regarding registration activities. The survey invitation will be sent to PCCs and ACCs on October 16 and will include a Survey Monkey link. The survey, which will be open for 30 days, will ask questions regarding user experience with CORES functionality, in particular New Entity Registrations and My Entity updates. There are four parts to the survey, including the ERO Portal, New Registrations, My Entity, and Training. The ERO Enterprise will use the survey results to focus on enhancing future releases with the registered entities' perspective. Survey Monkey estimated that most respondents will be able to complete the survey between 1–7 minutes.

NEW NERC Filings

On September 28, 2020, NERC submitted to FERC the following two filings:

- Annual Report of NERC on Wide-Area Analysis of Technical Feasibility Exceptions: NERC submitted to FERC the 2020 Annual Report of the Wide-Area Analysis of Technical Feasibility Exceptions in compliance with Paragraphs 220 and 221 of FERC's Order No. 706.
- Compliance Filing on Five-Year Order: NERC submitted its second <u>compliance filing</u> in response to FERC's five-year performance review Order. This filing includes Rules of Procedure updates relating to the Certification Program; NERC's Infrastructure Security Program; the Compliance Monitoring and Enforcement Program's Sanction Guidelines; and the Registration Program. This compliance filing also addresses the directive to provide additional information on the E-ISAC's use of All Points Bulletins as a way to increase industry awareness of security threats and vulnerabilities.
