## **Joint Industry Webinar Announced**

The North American Transmission Forum (NATF), along with ReliabilityFirst and SERC, is hosting an industry-wide special webinar on "Identifying and Managing Potential Compromise of Network Interface Cards" on October 22, 2020 from 3:00–4:30 p.m. Eastern. This webinar is being presented as part of a pilot collaboration between the NATF, ReliabilityFirst, and SERC focused on mitigation practices that entities can employ on their systems, equipment, and networks to reduce risk introduced via the supply chain. The webinar will feature an overview of the NERC/FERC Joint Staff White Paper on Supply Chain Vendor Identification, in addition to the following planned topics:

- Overview of NATF-ERO Collaboration Pilot
- NATF Supplier Cyber Security Assessment Model: How Entity Mitigation Fits In
- Regional Entity Perspectives on Network Interface Card (NIC) Compromise Risks and Mitigation
- NATF Member Subject Matter Expert Perspectives/Experiences with NIC Compromise Mitigation

## **CORES Survey Notice**

The ERO Enterprise will be seeking feedback regarding functionality on the ERO Portal regarding registration activities. The survey invitation will be sent to PCCs and ACCs on October 16 and will include a Survey Monkey link. The survey, which will be open for 30 days, will ask questions regarding user experience with CORES functionality, in particular New Entity Registrations and My Entity updates. There are four parts to the survey, including the ERO Portal, New Registrations, My Entity, and Training. The ERO Enterprise will use the survey results to focus on enhancing future releases with the registered entities' perspective. Survey Monkey estimated that most respondents will be able to complete the survey between 1–7 minutes.

## **NEW 2020 Reliability and Security Technical Committee Sector 8 Special Election Results**

The Reliability and Security Technical Committee (RSTC) opened nominations for filling a vacancy in Sector 8 (Large end-use electricity customer) from August 28 through September 18. As more than one nomination was received balloting was required for that sector from September 21 through October 5. Travis Fisher (Electricity Consumers Resource Council (ELCON)) was elected to fill the vacancy and will serve the remainder of the vacated term, pending NERC Board of Trustees approval at its November 5, 2020 meeting.

## **NEW Reminder to Submit Nominations for Compliance and Certification Committee**

The Compliance and Certification Committee (CCC) is requesting nominations to fill several at-large positions, which are intended to balance the needs of the CCC and to ensure performance of its responsibilities under the NERC Rules of Procedure. Nominations are being accepted through **October 14, 2020**. The following positions are currently open for nominations to the CCC:

• 2 – At-Large Membership



The revised Charter also allows the CCC to convert any sector vacancy to an at-large position to fill that seat until the end of the term when there is no qualified sector candidate. Therefore, the following sector seats are also open for at-large nominations because there were no nominations for these sectors during the recent request for nominations:

- 2 Large End-Use Electricity Customer
- 1 Small End-Use Electricity Customer

The CCC has an open nomination process. Individuals or recognized industry groups may nominate candidates for consideration. Terms will be for three years and will begin on January 1, 2021 after NERC Board approval of membership appointments at its scheduled meeting in November and pending FERC approval of the revised CCC Charter.
