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## GENERAL COMPLIANCE AND ENFORCEMENT NEWS

## **Reporting Mechanisms for CIP-008-6**

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Effective January 1, 2021, applicable NERC registered entities must comply with the expanded incident reporting requirements in revised Reliability Standard <u>CIP-008-6</u>. Reports must be submitted to the E-ISAC and, for those entities subject to the jurisdiction of the United States, the U.S. Department of Homeland Security Cybersecurity, and Infrastructure Agency (DHS CISA). Staff should work with their Compliance departments on their entity's specific requirements and obligations.
