# **NEW** Nomination Period Open for Standards Committee Special Election for Segment 4

The Standards Committee (SC) is seeking nominations through April 20, 2021 in preparation for a special election for Segment 4. Registered Ballot Body (RBB) members and others interested in NERC Reliability Standards are encouraged to submit nominations for industry segment representatives on the SC.

Anyone may submit a nomination. To be eligible, a nominee shall be an employee

or agent of an entity belonging in the applicable Segment. To allow verification of affiliation, a nominee must be a registered user in the NERC <u>RBB</u>. It is not required that the nominee be the same person as the entity's RBB representative for the applicable Segment. Instructions are



provided in the <u>Election of Members of the NERC Standards Committee Procedure</u> and nomination forms are posted on the <u>Standards Committee</u> <u>Election web page</u>. To submit a nomination, complete the nomination form and submit to <u>Katrina Blackley</u> no later than **April 20, 2021**. Once received, nominations will be posted on the SC's Nominations and Election web page. The special election will be conducted April 29– May 9, 2021. Election results will be announced shortly after the election closes.

# **NEW ERO Enterprise Launches Align Project and the ERO Secure Evidence** Locker

The ERO Enterprise is pleased to announce the Release 1 launch of the Align tool and the ERO Secure Evidence Locker (SEL) for MRO, NERC, and Texas RE as of March 31, 2021. The Align Project, formerly known as the Compliance Monitoring and Enforcement Program (CMEP) Technology Project, is a culmination of strategic efforts that began in 2014 with the goal of improving and standardizing processes across the ERO Enterprise, enhancing the efficiency of ERO Enterprise operations and improving the effectiveness of executing statutory functions.

Align moves all compliance monitoring and enforcement business processes to a common standardized platform, resulting in a consistent application of the ERO Enterprise CMEP and a more secure method of managing and storing CMEP evidence and data. The ERO SEL—a key component of the reimagined suite of CMEP work and data management tools—provides a secure, isolated environment to collect and protect compliance monitoring and enforcement evidence, significantly reducing risk of loss or exposure of evidence and harmonizing evidence collection processes.

"This is a giant step forward for consistency in our processes and security of the data we handle across the ERO Enterprise," said Sonia Mendonca, NERC's senior vice president, general counsel and corporate secretary. "The Align project team—made up of staff from across the ERO Enterprise—has dedicated years to this project and spent the balance of 2020 developing and testing the ERO SEL and preparing training materials.
