nonsynchronous sources was identified in *NERC's 2017 Long-term Reliability Assessment*. In response to the concern, the Planning Committee (PC) assigned the System Analysis and Modeling Subcommittee (SAMS) to study the issue. The SAMS developed the *Applicability of Transmission-Connected Reactive Devices* white paper, which was approved by the PC at its December 2019 meeting. The PC Executive Committee reviewed the draft SAR from SAMS at its January meeting and subsequently approved the SAR by email vote ending on February 11, 2020. The SAR was posted for industry comment March 30–May 13, 2020, and drafting team member nominations were solicited. However, the project was temporarily paused before a SAR drafting team was appointed.

An unofficial Word version of the nomination form is posted on the <u>Standard Drafting Team Vacancies</u> page and the <u>project page</u>. By submitting a nomination form, you are indicating your willingness and agreement to actively participate in face-to-face meetings and conference calls. The time commitment for this project is expected to be one face-to-face meetings per quarter (on average two full working days each meeting) with conference calls scheduled as needed to meet the agreed upon timeline the team sets forth. Face-to-face meetings will be conducted only when CDC health guidelines permit. Team members may also have side projects, either individually or by sub-group, to present for discussion and review. Lastly, an important component of the team effort is outreach. Members of the team will be expected to conduct industry outreach during the development process to support a successful ballot. Previous drafting team experience is beneficial but not required. The Standards Committee is expected to appoint members to the drafting team in June or July 2021. Nominees will be notified shortly after they have been appointed.



NEW Supplemental Nomination Period Open for Project 2020-01 SAR Drafting Team Members

NERC is seeking additional nominations for SAR drafting team members—specifically, employees with MOD-025/PRC-019 experience from Transmission Planner registered entities—through 8 p.m. Eastern, Thursday, May 20, 2021. Use the electronic form to submit a nomination. Contact Linda Jenkins regarding issues using the electronic form. An unofficial Word version of the nomination form is posted on the Standard Drafting Team Vacancies page and the project page. By submitting a nomination form, you are indicating your willingness and agreement to actively participate in face-to-face meetings and conference calls. The time commitment for this project can be up to two face-to-face meetings per quarter (on average two full working days each meeting) with conference calls scheduled as needed to meet the agreed upon timeline the team sets forth. Team members may also have side projects, either individually or by sub-group, to present for discussion and review. Lastly, an important component of the team effort is outreach. Members of the team will be expected to conduct industry outreach during the development process to support a successful ballot. Previous drafting team experience is beneficial but not required. The Standards Committee is expected to appoint members to the SAR drafting team in June 2021. Nominees will be notified shortly after they have been appointed.

NEW Nomination Period Open for Standards Committee Special Election for Segment 5

Section 5 – Electric Generators of the Standards Committee currently has a vacancy for the remainder of the 2020–2021 term. The Standards Committee is accepting nominations through May 24, 2021 in preparation for a special election for Segment 5. Registered Ballot Body (RBB) members and others interested in NERC Reliability Standards are encouraged to submit nominations for industry segment representatives on the SC. Reliability Standards are mandatory for all bulk power system owners, operators, and users in North America, and the SC's oversight role is therefore increasingly important. The SC consists of two members from each of the ten Industry Segments that make up the RBB. In addition, Appendix 3B of the Rules of Procedure contains special provisions to be used to achieve a balance of representation between the United States and Canada. The SC is elected by industry stakeholders and reports directly to the NERC Board of Trustees. The SC meets up to twelve times each year with meetings usually being held virtually. The <u>Standards Committee Charter</u> provides a description of the SC's responsibilities.

Anyone may submit a nomination. To be eligible for nomination, a nominee shall be an employee or agent of an entity belonging in the applicable Segment. To allow verification of affiliation, a nominee must be a registered user in the NERC RBB. It is not required that the nominee be the same person as the entity's RBB representative for the applicable Segment. Instructions are provided in the Election of Members of the NERC Standards Committee Procedure and nomination forms are posted on the Standards Committee Election web page. To submit a nomination, complete the attached nomination form and submit to Katrina Blackley no later than May 24, 2021. Once received, nominations will be posted on the SC's Nominations and Election web page. The special election will be conducted June 3–10, 2021. Election results will be announced shortly after the election closes.



NEW Nomination Results and Opening of Standards Committee Special Election for Segment 4

In accordance with the Procedure for Election of Members of the SC contained in Appendix 3B of the NERC Rules of Procedure, to be elected a nominee must meet both of the following criteria:

- Receive the highest total number of votes in that Segment; and
- Receive a simple majority of the votes cast in that Segment.
