guideline and approved a 45-day posting for industry comment.			



STANDARDS NEWS

NEW Results for Standards Committee Executive Committee Action without a Meeting

In accordance with Sections 7.0 and 8.0 of the Standards Committee Charter, an email ballot was sent on June 24, 2021 requesting the Standards Committee Executive Committee (SCEC) vote by June 30, 2021 to approve the following resolution:

Authorize initial posting of proposed Reliability Standard CIP-003-X and the associated Implementation Plan for a 45-day formal comment period, with ballot pool formed in the first 30 days, and parallel initial ballots and non-

binding polls on the Violation Risk Factors (VRFs) and Violation Severity Levels (VSLs), conducted during the last 10 days of the comment period.

SCEC members voted and the motion passed with four affirmative votes, zero abstention, and zero negative votes. The original motion and voting results were emailed to the SC members on July 8, 2021.

NEW Nomination Period Open for Project 2021-06 – Modifications to IRO-010 and TOP-003

NERC is seeking nominations for Project 2021-06 – Modifications to IRO-010 and TOP-003 drafting team members through **8 p.m. Eastern, Friday, August 6, 2021**. Previous drafting or review team experience is beneficial, but not required.

The time commitment for this project is expected to be one meeting per quarter (on average two and a half full working days each meeting) with calls scheduled as needed to meet the agreed-upon timeline the review or drafting team sets forth. Team members may also have side projects, either individually or by subgroup, to present to the larger team for discussion and review. Lastly, an important component of the review and drafting team effort is outreach. Members of the team will be expected to conduct industry outreach during the development process to support a successful project outcome. NERC is seeking individuals who have subject matter expertise with methods of data entry and data exchange processes.

the nomination form is posted on the <u>Standard Drafting Team Vacancies</u> page and the <u>project page</u>. The Standards Committee is expected to appoint members to the drafting team in August 2021. Nominees will be notified shortly after they have been appointed.

REMINDER 2021 Registered Ballot Body Self-Select Attestation Process

NERC Standards staff initiated the 2021 Annual Registered Ballot Body (RBB) Self-Select Process on June 8, 2021.

Each year, all RBB voting members are required to confirm that there have been no material changes in the last 12 months that affect the entity's current Segment selection(s), thus the entity continues to meet the Segment qualifications as outlined in the NERC Rules of Procedure, <u>Appendix 3D: RBB Criteria</u>.

RBB members should log into the <u>Standards Balloting and Commenting System (SBS)</u> first, stay logged in, and click the <u>link</u> (or copy and paste <u>https://sbs.nerc.net/Attestation/SubmitAttestation/4</u> into another web browser window) to open the attestation page.

NERC must receive a response for all segments represented in the RBB by the scheduled close date of August 9, 2021. Entities with segment(s) not attested for will be removed from the SBS. Anyone removed (un-vetted) can re-apply at any time. For more information or assistance, contact Wendy Muller.

GENERAL COMPLIANCE AND ENFORCEMENT NEWS

NEW Program Alignment Update

The ERO Enterprise Program Alignment Process is intended to enhance efforts to identify, prioritize, and resolve alignment issues across the ERO Enterprise. Using this process, NERC captures identified issues from the various resources in a <u>centralized repository</u>. The Consistency Reporting Tool uses a third-party application, EthicsPoint, which allows stakeholders to submit consistency issues—anonymously, if desired.

NERC added a self-identified alignment issue pertaining to CMEP practice guide on considerations for ERO Enterprise CMEP staff on Contingencies performed by Transmission Planners for use in TPL-001-4 and TPL-001-5.1 studies.

OTHER NEWS

NEW FERC, NERC, Regional Entity Staff Make Recommendations for Grid Operating Assessments

On July 8, 2021, staff from FERC and NERC and its Regional Entities issued a <u>report</u> outlining recommendations for real-time assessments of grid operating conditions. Real-time assessments evaluate system conditions using real-time data to measure existing and potential operating conditions to ensure continued reliable operation of the Bulk Electric System. The joint staff review focuses on strategies and techniques used by reliability coordinators and transmission operators to perform these assessments following a loss or degradation of data or tools used to maintain situational awareness. The review included on-site discussions with representatives of nine participating reliability coordinators and transmission operators. The full announcement is available <u>here</u>.
