<p>Comment Period Open for Draft Reliability Guideline: NERC’s Reliability and Security Technical Committee (RSTC) has requested the System Planning Impacts from Distributed Energy Resources (SPIDER) Working Group to “provide guidance on impacts that higher penetration of DER may have on system restoration, UVLS, and UFLS, and potential solutions or recommended practices to overcome any identified issues.” The Recommended Approaches for UFLS Program Design with Increasing Penetrations of DERs Draft Reliability Guideline provides guidance on impacts that a higher penetration of DER may have on underfrequency load shedding (UFLS) programs, as well as recommended practices to overcome identified issues. The first section discusses the background and importance of UFLS to bulk power system reliability, as determined by FERC in Order No. 763. The second section discusses impacts of DER to electrical island-level frequency, which UFLS programs are designed to support. The third section discusses impacts of DER to UFLS program design. The fourth section concludes with recommendations. NEW Nomination Period Extended for Project 2021-05 – Modifications to PRC-023 Drafting Team Members

NERC is seeking additional nominations for Project 2021-05 – Modifications to PRC-023 drafting team members through 8 p.m. Eastern, Tuesday, **August 10, 2021**. The time commitment for this project is expected to be one meeting per quarter (on average two and a half full working days each meeting) with calls scheduled as needed to meet the agreed-upon timeline the review or drafting team sets forth. Team members may also have side projects, either individually or by subgroup, to present to the larger team for discussion and review. Lastly, an important component of the review and drafting team effort is outreach. Members of the team will be expected to conduct industry outreach during the development process to support a successful project outcome. NERC is seeking individuals who have subject matter expertise with Protection & Controls and are familiar with NERC Standard PRC-023.

Previous drafting or review team experience is beneficial, but not required. A brief description of the desired qualifications, expected commitment, and other pertinent information is included below. By submitting a nomination form, you are indicating your willingness and agreement to actively participate in face-to-face meetings and conference calls. NEW Program Alignment Update

NERC added a self-identified alignment issue pertaining to CMEP practice guide on considerations for ERO Enterprise CMEP staff on practices around understanding entity risk and evaluating entity practices, relative to cold weather preparedness. The ERO Enterprise Program Alignment Process is intended to enhance efforts to identify, prioritize, and resolve alignment issues across the ERO Enterprise. Using this process, NERC captures identified issues from the various resources in a [centralized repository](#). The Consistency Reporting Tool uses a third-party application, EthicsPoint, which allows stakeholders to submit consistency issues—anonously, if desired.

REMINDER 2021 NERC Membership Renewal Period Closing

NEW Technical Reference Document, Tool, and Survey Posted

The Security Working Group's (SWG) Assessing and Reducing Risk Reference Document and Risk Tool were approved at the Reliability and Security Technical Committee (RSTC) meeting on June 8, 2021. The document and tool were developed as a collaborative effort by volunteers from the RSTC, the SWG, NERC, and National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST).

The [Risk Reference document](#) can help organizations evaluate their security and compliance posture and determine how to address any gaps that are identified. The [Risk Tool](#) maps requirements of the CIP Reliability Standards to the NIST Cybersecurity Framework. A [tool survey](#) has also been developed; users are asked to complete it so the SWG can use the results to identify areas where improvements could be made. For
