# **NEW Robb, Lauby and Cancel Spoke at FERC's 2021 Annual Reliability Technical Conference**

Jim Robb, NERC's president and CEO, Mark Lauby, NERC's senior vice president and chief engineer, and Manny Cancel, NERC's senior vice president and CEO of NERC's Electricity Information Sharing and Analysis Center (E-ISAC) participated in FERC's 2021 Annual Reliability Technical Conference on September 30. The annual conference was comprised of four panels that discussed reliability issues related to the bulk power system:

- Panel 1: Bulk Power System Reliability and Security: Current State, Challenges and Initiatives, featuring a presentation from Robb and Lauby

- Panel 3: Managing Cyber Risks in the Electric Power Sector, featuring remarks from Cancel

#### **NEW NERC Filings**

On September 29, 2021:

- NERC and the Regional Entities submitted to FERC a <u>petition</u> for approval of revisions to the NERC ROP related to the Compliance Monitoring and Enforcement Program (CMEP), the Personnel Certification and Credential Maintenance Program, and the Training and Education Program.
- NERC filed an <u>amendment</u> to its request for acceptance of its 2022 business plan and budget, 2022 business plans and budgets of the Regional Entities, and for approval of proposed assessments to fund the budgets.
- NERC submitted to FERC the <u>2021 Annual Report of the Wide-Area Analysis of Technical Feasibility Exceptions</u> in compliance with Paragraphs 220 and 221 of FERC's Order No. 706.
