ORDER

- Notices, in English and in French, in the form attached hereto and marked "A" are to be provided by Board staff to all registered entities, NERC and NPCC on or before Wednesday April 9, 2014;
- English and French notices in the form attached hereto and marked "A" are to be posted on the Board's website at www.nbeub.ca commencing no later than Wednesday April 9, 2014 and shall remain posted until at least Monday, June 9, 2014.
- 4. Registered entities, NERC and NPCC are invited to submit written comment to the Board regarding the Application on or before Monday, June 9, 2014 at general@nbeub.ca or by mail at the address below. Please refer to Matter 246 in your correspondence.
