IN THE MATTER of an Application by New Brunswick Power Corporation pursuant to the *Electricity Act* and with respect to Reliability Standards PRC-005, PRC-008, PRC-011 and PRC-017.

ORDER

WHEREAS the New Brunswick Energy and Utilities Board (Board) has received an Application from the New Brunswick Power Corporation (the "Corporation") pursuant to the *Electricity Act* and the *Reliability Standards Regulation* seeking an Order as follows:

- (1) approving modifications of Board approved reliability standard PRC-005-1.1b by approving new version PRC-005-2 and NB Appendix PRC-005-2-NB-0.
- (2) approving retirement of existing Board approved reliability standard PRC-005-1.1b,
- (3) approving retirement of existing Board approved reliability standard PRC-008-0,
- (4) approving retirement of existing Board approved reliability standard PRC-011-0,
- (5) approving retirement of existing Board approved reliability standard PRC-017-0 and
- (6) such other order and/or direction as the Board may see fit.

AND WHEREAS pursuant to section 8 of the *Reliability Standards Regulation* the Board is required to notify all registered entities, the North American Electric Reliability

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Corporation (NERC) as the standards body and the Northeast Power Coordinating

Council (NPCC) as the compliance body, of this Application;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to section 8 of the Reliability Standards Regulation the Board

is required to post the Application on its website;

NOW THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. A copy of the Application shall be posted on the Board's website at www.nbeub.ca

commencing no later than Wednesday April 30, 2014 in both English and French;

2. Notices, in English and in French, in the form attached hereto and marked "A" are

to be provided by Board staff to all registered entities, NERC and NPCC on or

before Wednesday April 30, 2014;

3. English and French notices in the form attached hereto and marked "A" are to be

posted on the Board's website at www.nbeub.ca commencing no later than

Wednesday April 30, 2014 and shall remain posted until at least Monday, June

30, 2014.

4. Registered entities, NERC and NPCC are invited to submit written comments to

the Board regarding the Application on or before Monday, June 30, 2014 at

your correspondence.
