## NEW BRUNSWICK ENERGY AND UTILITIES BOARD

**IN THE MATTER** of reliability standards INT-001, INT-003, INT-004, INT-005, INT-006, INT-007, INT-008, INT-009, INT-010, INT-011 and Section 119 (1) of the *Electricity Act*, S.N.B. 2013, c. 7.

## ORDER

WHEREAS the New Brunswick Energy and Utilities Board (Board) has received an Application and evidence (Application) from the New Brunswick Power Corporation (NB Power) pursuant to the *Electricity Act S.N.B. 2013 c. 7* and pursuant to *Regulation 2013-66*, being the *Reliability Standards Regulation-Electricity Act* seeking the following approval:

- a) an Order
  - approving modifications of Board approved reliability standard INT-004-2 by approving new version INT-004-3 and NB Appendix INT-004-3-NB-0,
  - (2) approving retirement of existing Board approved reliability standard INT-004-2,
  - (3) approving retirement of existing Board approved reliability standard INT-001-3,
  - (4) approving modifications of Board approved reliability standard INT-006-3 by approving new version INT-006-4 and NB Appendix INT-006-4-NB-0,

- (5) approving retirement of existing Board approved reliability standard INT-006-3,
- (6) approving retirement of existing Board approved reliability standard INT-007-1 and NB Appendix INT-007-1-NB-0,
- (7) approving retirement of existing Board approved reliability standard INT-008-3,
- (8) approving modifications of Board approved reliability standard INT-009-1 by approving new version INT-009-2 and NB Appendix INT-009-2-NB-0,
- (9) approving retirement of existing Board approved reliability standard INT-009-1,
- (10) approving retirement of existing Board approved reliability standard INT-003-3,
- (11) approving modifications of Board approved reliability standard INT-010-1 by approving new version INT-010-2 and NB Appendix INT-010-2-NB-0,
- (12) approving retirement of existing Board approved reliability standard INT-010-1,
- (13) approving reliability standard INT-011-1 and NB Appendix INT-011-1-NB-0,
- (14) approving retirement of existing Board approved reliability standard INT-005-3, and
- b) orders and/or directions with respect to such other matters as the Board sees fit.

**AND WHEREAS** pursuant to section 8 of the *Reliability Standards Regulation-Electricity* 

Act the Board is required to notify all registered entities, the North American Electric

Reliability Corporation (NERC) as the standards body and the Northeast Power

Coordinating Council (NPCC) as the compliance body, of this Application;

**AND WHEREAS** pursuant to section 8 of the *Reliability Standards Regulation-Electricity* 

Act the Board is required to post the Application on its website;

**NOW THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

2. Notices, in both English and French, in the form attached hereto and marked "A"

are to be provided by Board staff to all registered entities, NERC and NPCC on or

before Thursday September 11, 2014;

3. Notices, in both English and French, in the form attached hereto and marked

"A" are to be posted on the Board's website at www.nbeub.ca commencing no

later than Thursday September 11, 2014 and shall remain posted until at least

Tuesday November 11, 2014;

4. Written comments on the Application are to be received in the Board's offices on

or before Tuesday November 11, 2014. Written comments can be emailed to

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- 5. Pursuant to section 8 of the *Reliability Standards Regulation-Electricity Act*, the Board shall approve the requested Application together with any non-substantive modifications it considers appropriate:
  - (a) if NB Power makes no recommendation for any substantive modification to the reliability standards as approved by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission of the United States of America (FERC) and
  - (b) if, during the comment period, there are no substantive comments received from a registered entity, the standards body or the compliance body.
- 6. If the requested modifications or comments are substantive, a hearing shall be held by the Board in respect of the Application.
