

NEW BRUNSWICK ENERGY AND UTILITIES BOARD

IN THE MATTER of reliability standard PRC-023, PRC-025 and section 119(1) of the *Electricity Act*, S.N.B. 2013 c.7

ORDER

WHEREAS the New Brunswick Energy and Utilities Board (Board) has received an Application and evidence (Application) from the New Brunswick Power Corporation (NB Power) pursuant to the *Electricity Act S.N.B. 2013 c. 7* and pursuant to *Regulation 2013-66*, being the *Reliability Standards Regulation-Electricity Act* seeking the following approval:

(a) an Order:

- (1) approving modifications of Board approved reliability standard PRC-023-2 by approving new version PRC-023-3 and NB Appendix PRC-023-3-NB-0,
- (2) approving retirement of existing Board approved reliability standard PRC-023-2, and
- (3) approving reliability standard PRC-025-1 and NB Appendix PRC-025-1-NB-0.

(b) orders and/or directions with respect to such other matters as the Board sees fit.

AND WHEREAS pursuant to section 8 of the *Reliability Standards Regulation-Electricity Act* the Board is required to notify all registered entities, the North American Electric Reliability Corporation (NERC) as the standards body and the Northeast Power Coordinating Council (NPCC) as the compliance body, of this Application;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to section 8 of the *Reliability Standards Regulation-Electricity Act* the Board is required to post the Application on its website;

NOW THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. A copy of the Application shall be posted on the Board's website at www.nbeub.ca commencing no later than November 28, 2014 in both English and French;
2. Notices, in both English and French, in the form attached hereto and marked "A" are to be provided by Board staff to all registered entities, NERC and NPCC on or before Friday, November 28, 2014;
3. Notices, in both English and French, in the form attached hereto and marked "A" are to be posted on the Board's website at www.nbeub.ca commencing no later than Friday November 28, 2014 and shall remain posted until at least Tuesday January 27, 2015;
4. Written comments on the Application are to be received in the Board's offices on or before Tuesday January, 27, 2015. Written comments can be emailed to general@nbeub.ca or by using the contact information below. Please refer to Matter No. 273 in your correspondence.

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5. Pursuant to section 8 of the *Reliability Standards Regulation-Electricity Act*, the Board shall approve the requested Application together with any non-substantive modifications it considers appropriate if:
- (a) if NB Power makes no recommendation for any substantive modification to the reliability standards as approved by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission of the United States of America (FERC) and
 - (b) if NB Power makes no recommendation for any substantive modifications to revisions approved to the equivalent reliability standards approved by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission of the United States of America (FERC) and
 - (c) if, during the comment period, there are no substantive comments received from a registered entity, the standards body or the compliance body.
6. Also pursuant to section 8 of the *Reliability Standards Regulation-Electricity Act* the Board shall retire a reliability standard if the application indicates the date on which the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) approved the retirement of the equivalent standard and if the comments received by the Board are not substantive
7. If the requested modifications or comments are substantive, a hearing shall be held by the Board in respect of the Application.
