Intervenor North American Electric Reliability Corporation (NERC) hereby provides comments in response to the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) Procedural Order No. 1, filed in the above-referenced docket on September 11, 2018. In the Order, the OEB seeks submissions regarding whether proposed Reliability Standard TPL-007-2 - *Transmission System Planned Performance for Geomagnetic Disturbance Events* should be stayed in Ontario pending the OEB's determination of the application filed by the Independent Electricity System Operator (IESO) and Hydro One Networks Inc. (Hydro One).

NERC supports a stay of the proposed standard in Ontario pending the OEB's review. Such a stay would not harm reliability, as entities in Ontario are currently implementing requirements to perform GMD Vulnerability Assessments under the first version of the standard, TPL-007-1.

Also, and as noted in the Order, the IESO and Hydro One have submitted a standard authorization request to NERC to seek a variance to the proposed standard. This request was accepted, and a standard drafting team consisting of individuals from several Canadian provinces was appointed to develop a TPL-007 Canadian variance in accordance with NERC's standard development process. An initial draft of the variance was posted for informal comment from August 10, 2018 through September 9, 2018. The standard drafting team is currently reviewing the submitted comments and preparing a second draft of the variance. NERC anticipates that the draft variance will be posted for a 45-day public comment period and ballot beginning in October 2018.¹
