The North American Electric Reliability Corporation (“NERC”) hereby submits this filing in compliance with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission’s Order on Rehearing and Clarification and Compliance Filing in the above-referenced proceedings.¹ Paragraph 2 of the Commission’s Order directed NERC to register on NERC’s Compliance Registry the Ohio Valley Electric Corporation (“OVEC”) as a load-serving entity (“LSE”) for the United States Department of Energy, Portsmouth/Paducah Project Office (“DOE Portsmouth”) load. In accordance with the Commission’s order, on November 13, 2012, NERC advised OVEC it was registered as a LSE for the DOE Portsmouth and included on the NERC Compliance Registry (“NCR”).
