Dear Ms. Bose:

In Order No. 693, Paragraph 629, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("FERC") directed the North American Electric Reliability Corporation ("NERC") to provide a quarterly informational filing regarding the timeframe to restore power to the auxiliary power systems of U.S. nuclear power plants following a blackout as determined during simulations and drills of system restoration plans. In the first, second, third, and fourth quarter compliance filings for 2010, in the above referenced docket, NERC included a request to terminate its obligation to file such quarterly information filings.

By this letter NERC withdraws its request to terminate its quarterly informational filing obligation. NERC submits this request without prejudice, and NERC reserves the right to renew the request at any time in the future.
