Dear Ms. Bose:

In response to Paragraph 94 of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's (FERC or the Commission) December 19, 2008 Order, the North American Electric Reliability Corporation (NERC), on behalf of itself and the Northeast Power Coordinating Council, Inc. (NPCC) hereby submits this compliance filing. The Commission directed NERC and NPCC to submit a filing regarding NPCC's use of technical committee consultations. The Commission directed:

NERC and NPCC to submit non-public reports to the Commission staff on technical committee consultations during that calendar quarter that list: (i) the topic of each consultation initiated or continued during that quarter; (ii) the date on which the consultation began and ended; (iii) the reason why NPCCs taff i nitiated the consultation; (iv) the persons who participated in the consultation; and (v) the result of the consultation, if any. Finally, we require NERC and NPCC to submit a filing on or before June 30, 2010 that incorporates the results of these quarterly reports and proposes a schedule for the termination of the consultations or a detailed justification for their continuation.

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NERC submitted NPCC's quarterly reports regarding technical committee consultations to FERC on May 4, 2009, July 30, 2009, October 27, 2009, January 26, 2010 and May 7, 2010.<sup>2</sup> All five of the quarterly reports indicated that NPCC did not initiate any technical committee consultations. NPCC also reports that it did not make use of technical committee consultations for compliance purposes during the second quarter 2010.

Additionally, on June 9, 2010, NERC submitted a filing containing Revised Regional Delegation Agreements.<sup>3</sup> Among other proposed changes, the provision regarding the use of technical committee consultations in the enforcement process was deleted from Section 3.0 – Other Decision-Making Bodies of Exhibit D – Compliance Monitoring and Enforcement Program to the NPCC Delegation Agreement.<sup>4</sup> Further, pending approval of the NPCC Revised Regional Delegation Agreement, NPCC states it will not make use of technical committee consultations for compliance purposes.

Upon Commission approval of the June 9, 2010 filing and the revised NPCC Regional Delegation Agreement, the provision regarding technical committee consultation will be eliminated. Under the circumstances, NERC respectfully requests that the Commission terminate the quarterly reporting requirement.

Accordingly, NERC respectfully requests that the Commission accept this filing and terminate the quarterly reporting requirement.
