Brief biographical sketch of nominee including present position	Daniela Hammons is Director of Policy & Compliance for CenterPoint Energy Houston Electric, LLC and has over 21 years of experience in the electric utility industry. Over the last 14 years, Daniela has helped establish and develop CenterPoint Energy’s comprehensive NERC Reliability Standards compliance program. She leads compliance teams in CenterPoint Energy Houston Electric (within Texas RE) and Southern Indiana Gas and Electric (within ReliabilityFirst) that collaborate with CenterPoint Energy operating departments to ensure policies, procedures, and documentation meet applicable NERC Reliability Standards and are supported by documented internal controls. Daniela’s responsibilities also include evaluating standards

	under development, developing comments, and voting on balloted projects.

The Company’s NERC Reliability Standards compliance program is tested annually using a risk-based approach to validate adherence to NERC Reliability Standards.
Description of nominee’s compliance enforcement experience/knowledge (e.g. regulatory process, ERO rules of procedure, NERC sanctioning guidelines etc.)	Daniela coordinates CenterPoint Energy’s compliance and enforcement efforts for formal audits, data submittals, and requests for information. She also oversees the Company’s self-logging program.
