## 2. Development of Comment Responses and Associated Changes

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The drafting team reviewed comments received on MOD-030, MOD-008, MOD-028, MOD-001, and MOD-029. Initial Responses were finalized, and in-depth discussion on remaining items occurred. The drafting team spent time reviewing the following areas in detail:

- The inclusion of timing requirements in R10 of MOD-030. This language was made to be more consistent with that in MOD-001.
- The use of a fixed default percentage for TRM (allowed in the currently drafted standard, but it must be documented and supported by data). The drafting team elected not to make any changes.
- The measures associated with ETC. The drafting team wrote a detailed explanation of how these are used.
- Requirements related to Consistency with Planning of Operations. The team agreed that all these should be addressed in MOD-001.
- Requirement R12 in TOP-002 currently may overlap with the ATC standards (Andy R to pursue having this addressed by the team working on TOP-002).

The drafting team completed the responses and drafts and prepared them for submission to the SC for posting. The drafting team also reviewed the status of CBM.
