## Additional Ballot and Non-Binding Poll Results

### **Now Available**

An additional ballot of **COM-002-4** Operating Personnel Communications Protocols and non-binding poll of the associated Violation Risk Factors and Violation Severity Levels concluded at **8 p.m. Eastern on Thursday, November 7, 2013**.

This standard achieved a quorum but did not receive sufficient affirmative votes for approval. Voting statistics are listed below, and the <u>Ballot Results</u> page provides a link to the detailed results for the additional ballot.

In response to this resolution, the drafting team will meet in Atlanta, GA on November 19, 2013 to consider comments and prepare a new draft of COM-002-4. The drafting team expects to post this new draft the week of December 2, 2013 so that the standard can be delivered to the Board at the February 2014 meeting, as directed in the resolution.
