Agenda

- 1. Review comments and discuss initial team responses on Interpretation of CIP-006-1
 - a. Scott Miller reviewed draft comments received from members and identified differences in responses. For many comments, more team discussion is necessary in order to find consensus.
 - b. Tim Conway discussed two themes that the team may consider in reviewing the interpretation request relative to the standard:
 - i. Is wiring meant to be included within "communication networks";
 - ii. Do physical access controls extend to logical controls, and if so, does that fit with the language of the standard?
 - c. The team also discussed appendix 3 to CIP-006-3c, which addresses wiring. More research and discussion is necessary.
- 2. Develop responses to comments and revise interpretation, if required, based on consensus of comments
 - a. Some comments were identified that the team could agree to respond to and drafted initial responses. Several comments require further work, but will likely be contingent upon whether, and to what extent, the team determines that the interpretation itself must change.



b. The team determined that it is likely that the interpretation may need some revision, and that such change will impact how the team will respond to the comments.
