- June 2020 Each Registered Ballot Body (RBB) voting member will receive a notification with a link to the Standards Balloting and Commenting System (SBS) electronic attestation page to confirm that there have been no material changes in the last 12 months that affect the entity's current Segment selection(s), thus the entity continues to meet the Segment qualifications (as outlined in the qualifications in <u>Appendix 3D: RBB Criteria</u>).
- August 2020 Deadline for all RBB members to self-select their segments via the SBS.

Notifications regarding the process will be sent via SBS/RBB email, Standards Committee communications, Standards, Compliance, and Enforcement Bulletins, and other NERC email alerts. Specific dates to be determined.

GENERAL COMPLIANCE AND ENFORCEMENT NEWS

NEW ERO Enterprise Releases New Guidance Temporarily Expanding Self-Logging Program Due to Coronavirus Impacts

LABILITY CORPORATION

The ERO Enterprise released new <u>guidance</u> providing additional regulatory relief related to registered entities' coronavirus response. The relief temporarily expands the Self-Logging Program to allow all registered entities to self-log instances of potential noncompliance with minimal or moderate risk related to their coronavirus response. While registered entities remain responsible for maintaining compliance with NERC Reliability Standards, this expansion allows them to focus their immediate efforts and resources on maintaining the safety of their workforce and

communities to assure the reliability of the bulk power system during this public health emergency. Under this temporary expansion of the Self-Logging Program, potential noncompliance related to coronavirus impacts and logged consistently with this guidance is expected to be resolved without further action. NEW NERC Receives New Alignment Issue via Consistency Reporting Tool

NERC received a new alignment issue pertaining to disposition of non-compliance described in March 18, 2020 joint FERC/NERC industry guidance to ensure grid reliability amid potential coronavirus impacts. The alleged issue is resolved, and <u>the Issues and Recommendations</u> <u>Tracking</u> document has been updated.

The ERO Enterprise Program Alignment Process is intended to enhance efforts to identify, prioritize, and resolve alignment issues across the ERO Enterprise. Using this process, NERC captures identified issues from the various resources in a <u>centralized repository</u>. The Consistency Reporting Tool uses a third-party application, EthicsPoint, which allows stakeholders to submit consistency issues—anonymously, if desired.
